Barangaroo Metro Station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Besix Watpac are the new contractors for this site. They will be responsible for the full station fit out and finishing works. (Construction not design). • Construction Timetable: commencing Sept 2021, completion Dec 2023. • Acoustic shed is expected to be demolished H1 2023. • The presentation will be sent to MP CRAG and distributed to residents.
Candidates for City of Sydney Mayor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yvonne Weldon and Karen Freyer introduced themselves to the meeting and spoke about their upcoming run for the City of Sydney council and Mayoral office.
Heritage Council	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BK gave an overview of the Community Consultation evenings. The outcome was that a clear message was sent to Heritage Office, Heritage Council and The City of Sydney regarding residents' concerns. Heritage NSW have indicated that the community will be given feedback from the sessions.
Harry Jensen Centre	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • City of Sydney have proposed a new form of management for the HJC. MPCRAG sub-committee are developing the submission to access an "accommodation grant" from the City of Sydney, to be auspiced to the MP CRAG. Further discussions to be held.
Central Barangaroo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BK and Tim Gordon met with Rod McCoy from Aqualand on 17 June as part of their consultation process. The MP CRAG has resolved that a working group will be established to review documentation when it's released by Aqualand. The group to be formed by 23/7/2021. Interested members to contact BK.

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Short-Term Letting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Councilor Linda Scott has organised a petition to the NSW Government to return Short Term Letting to local government for regulation. As residents would be aware, the NSW Government has established specific regulation for it to regulate which is a poor outcome for our area.

Older Women's Network Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Property has been listed for sale. The DA has been withdrawn by Property NSW and the site is being sold as is.
