Fort Street Public School Community Update

3 December 2020

A project is underway to upgrade Fort Street Public School to cater to growing enrolments and provide exciting new spaces for learning and teaching. The upgrade will increase the school's capacity through a range of new and refurbished buildings, which will be sensitive to the area's character and heritage.

Temporary traffic changes and cycleway diversion

Construction of the Fort Street Public School upgrade is expected to begin in early 2021. As the Sydney Harbour Bridge southern cycleway passes through the school site, we will need to divert part of this cycleway for the duration of the construction of the school upgrade to ensure the safety of cyclists in this area.

The cycleway diversion will be an on-road route along Kent Street, Argyle Street and Watson Road (see map overleaf). Construction works for the cycleway diversion will start in early 2021. Once in place, the cycleway diversion will result in some changes to local traffic and parking (see map overleaf). These changes will be in place for the duration of construction works on the school project.

We will update you with specific dates for the cycleway construction works, the start date for the cycleway diversion and changes to local traffic and parking conditions once they have been determined.
